

## Meet Paris's Next Generation of Stylish Boutique Hotels

### Maison Albar Hotel Paris Céline

Housed within a 19th-century Haussmann-style structure that formerly served as the headquarters for Céline, the 60-room **Maison Albar Hotel Paris Céline** owes its elegant appeal to a multitude of legacies: Owner Céline Falco is a fourth-generation hotelier; the adjoining Odette restaurant's seasonal plate-sharing menu was developed by Caroline and Sophie, the up-and-coming daughters of the Michelin-star chef Michel Rostang; and the luxurious spa's Cinq Mômes brand was created by Paris's wellness power couple Jean-Louis and Nathalie Poiroux. While each guest room combines timeless earth-toned accents (velvet and silk furnishings, dark woods, and ivory curtains) with state-of-the-art tablet-based controls, the 1923 Suite is the ultimate Parisian fantasy pad boasting a ritzy two-level floorplan and 180-degree floor-to-ceiling rooftop city views.
