ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECTS

DIANI TURTLE WATCH

The Diamonds Leisure Beach and Golf Resort collaborates with Diani Turtle watch in protecting and preserving Turtle nests. The Resort has a designated sea Turtle nest relocation site at the Beach where Turtle eggs are protected until the hatchlings emerge between 55 and 75 days. Diani Turtle Watch is a pivotal initiative focused on conserving endangered sea turtles in the Diani Beach region. Through this program, local communities and tourists participate in monitoring and protecting turtle nests, as well as educating visitors about the importance of marine conservation. The initiative includes nest protection measures, and community awareness campaigns, ensuring a collaborative effort to preserve these magnificent creatures and their habitats.

COLOBUS MONKEY CONSERVATION CENTRE

The Diamonds Leisure Beach and Golf Resort collaborates with the Colobus Trust In educating Tourists about Colobus Conservation from the Hotel Colobus Conservation education centre. Diani Beach is home to the Angolan Black and white Colobus Monkey (Colobus angolensis palliates). The Colobus Monkey Conservation Centre is dedicated to safeguarding the region's unique primate species, particularly the Colobus monkeys. The Center plays a crucial role in rescue, rehabilitation, and research efforts. It provides a sanctuary for injured and orphaned monkeys, educates visitors on the ecological role of these primates, and promotes sustainable practices to protect their natural habitats. Visitors can learn about the Colobus monkeys' behavior, diet, and conservation challenges while supporting their protection.

BOTANICAL GARDEN

In an innovative approach to environmental education, the Diamonds Leisure Beach and Golf Resort features trees equipped with Botanical names. A Botanical QR code is available that provides a link to detailed information about the tree species, their ecological importance, and their role in the local ecosystem. This interactive educational tool enhances visitors' understanding and appreciation of the region's biodiversity, fostering a deeper connection to nature and promoting conservation awareness.

PLANT NURSERY

The plant nursery is instrumental in supporting the Diamonds Leisure Beach and Golf Resort landscaping efforts. It cultivates a variety of native and indigenous plant species, which are used for replanting initiatives and enhancing green spaces in the Resort. The nursery contributes to habitat restoration, biodiversity conservation, and the beautification of the resort, creating a sustainable environment for both wildlife and people.

BEACH CLEANING

Daily beach cleaning efforts by the Diamond's Leisure Beach and Golf Staff are crucial in maintaining the beauty and health of the Resort's shoreline. The local Community volunteers and visitors also periodically participate in organised clean-up events to remove litter and debris from the beach. These activities not only preserve the natural aesthetic of the coastline but also protect marine life from pollution, ensuring that the beach remains a safe and enjoyable environment for all.

JALARAM GIRLS SECONDARY SCHOOL

ENERGY AND WATER

SOLAR PANELS

To reduce reliance on non-renewable energy sources, the Diamonds Leisure Beach and Golf Resort invested in solar panels. These panels harness the power of the sun to generate clean, renewable energy, reducing greenhouse gas emissions and lowering energy costs. Solar energy not only supports sustainable operations but also serves as a model for responsible energy use within the Resort.

SUSTAINABLE WATER MANAGEMENT

The Diamonds Leisure Beach and Golf Resort has a Reverse Osmosis (RO) plant, which is a vital component of sustainable water management. It provides a reliable source of clean, purified water by removing contaminants from Bore hole water. The RO plant reduces the reliance on bottled water, minimising plastic waste and promoting the use of reusable containers. It also helps address water scarcity issues while ensuring that guests have access to safe drinking water.

BOTANICAL WALK

The botanical walk provides an educational journey through the Resort's diverse plant life. A Guided tour showcases various plant species, their uses, and their importance to the ecosystem. This walk highlights the value of plant conservation and the role of botanical diversity in maintaining ecological balance. It also offers visitors a chance to connect with nature and gain a deeper appreciation for the environment.

DIAMONDS LEISURE BEACH GOLF CLUB

The 18-hole championship golf course, which is home to the Diani Beach Masters is recognized as one of the most exciting golf courses in East Africa. Luscious green fairways run through palm, cashew nut and casuarina pine trees. The par 72, 6084-metre course has 85 bunkers and a large lake, which guarantees a challenging and exciting game of course.

The Golf Course is also home to a fascinating array of wild animals and birds, including the elusive wild pig, the nimble dik dik, and the charming guinea pig. Above, the players find graceful herons, and elegant egrets gliding through the air, while the calls of baboons, vervet monkeys, and colobus monkeys echo through the trees. The lush landscape is also a haven for a multitude of bird species, including the industrious weaver birds that weave their intricate nests among the branches.
